For informational interviews, you will have the option to conduct over the phone, in person, or through Skype. Please read the list carefully.
- 3) If you are matched with an alumnus through this program, we will contact you to confirm. Once you confirm, we will provide you with their contact information and proceed with a virtual introduction. It will be up to you to contact the alumnus directly to set up a mutually convenient day / time.
