



## In addition to traditional academic planning, our advisors help students:


- Develop an understanding of their strengths, interests, and values


#### **Activate NetID and Password**

Your student will need their SUID number to activate their NetID. They can find their SUID on the top right of their admissions notification. Their NetID and password are needed for access to MySlice, Patient Portal, WellnessPortal, and more.

## Remind your students:

- Their syr.edu should be checked DAILY for messages from different campus offices:
  - The Registrar's Office link for course registration
    Qualtrics survey
  - You Otto Know emails every Tuesday, from our office
  - Weekly communications from the <u>New Student</u>
    <u>Programs</u> office

#### **Preparing for Registration--Required Tasks DUE NOW!**

<u>Placement Exams</u>: provide information on appropriate course level based on proficiency.

#### WE RECOMMEND ALL STUDENTS TAKE MATH AND LANGUAGE PLACEMENT EXAMS -THE SOONER THE BETTER!

<u>Math and Foreign Language Placement Exams</u> are required for our course selection and registration process. Exams must be completed before registration can happen. No previous study is required. Due ASAP, but no later than June 23<sup>rd</sup>

#### English Language Assessment (ELAE)

Non-native speakers of English <u>must</u> take the English Language Assessment Exam. This exam will be administered online on June 9. <u>Registration</u> required by June 6<sup>th</sup> (Exam is offered on June 8<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup>).

### **Preparing for Registration-External Credit**

#### **Does your student have external credit?** If so:

- AP scores must be sent **from College Board account** to Syracuse University (code 2328)
- IB diplomas must be **submitted by high school** directly to Syracuse University
- Official transcripts for college credits (including dual enrollment) must be sent directly from the external College or University to: <u>astransfercredit@syr.edu</u>

#### Tips:

- Don't know your AP score yet? That is okay! Make sure College Board knows where to send them when they get released
- <u>Click here</u> for access to tables that outline minimum scores needed and SU course equivalences for AP/IB/CLEP, etc.

Qualtrics Survey: Each student has received a unique link to confirm their academic information and provide feedback on interests for course selection.

The Qualtrics submission deadline is June 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2023.

- Questions can be directed to their assigned academic and career advisor.
- Advisors will be holding office hours in June more to come!

Registration Timeline:

- Registration for major courses by advisor during June and July (based on Qualtrics survey data).
- Mandatory Registration Mechanics sessions starting the week of July 31<sup>st</sup>.
- Students will finish their own schedules August 7<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup>.

Immunization Records: Students must submit their health records by July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023, in order to prevent a hold on their account.

Additional Tasks: Please check <u>the Required Tasks website</u> regularly. Students will receive email reminders for tasks due via their @syr.edu email.

Update Contact information: Update student mobile number on MySlice  $\rightarrow$  Personal Profile tile  $\rightarrow$  Contact Details

## **Preparing for Registration--Optional Task**

#### **MySlice-Share My Access** (optional):

Students may share specific sections of their MySlice account with a parent or guardian. They can create up to three accounts for various individuals with different levels of access -financial aid, holds, grades, schedule, etc.

How to share? <u>Students initiate</u>: MySlice  $\rightarrow$  Share my Access tile on home page



Ongoing	Submit external credit; Complete other <u>required tasks (</u> health/financial/photo ID)
Now-June 23rd	Complete Registration Qualtrics survey (student was emailed their unique link in mid-May to @syr.edu)
Now-June 23rd	Take Placement Exams (no prep necessary)
Week of June 5th	Advisors hold drop-in Zoom sessions (evening) - check @syr.edu email for details
June 6th	ENL Registration due for students whose dominant language is not English
June 8th&10th	English Language Assessment for non-native speakers
June 23rd	Registration Qualtrics survey closes
July 13, 20, 27th	Advisors hold informational sessions on various topics - more details to come via syr.edu email
July 31st	Registration training sessions begin (1 session required, student selects time)
August 7-11th	Student Self-Registration to complete their schedule
August 17th	Advisors hold final informational session to answer questions/help students prepare to arrive on campus
August 24-27th	Syracuse Welcome (AUGUST 28th—1st Day of Classes!)
